

# Embrace Northern Colorado launches leadership task force

Embrace Northern Colorado, a nonprofit regional planning group, has formed a leadership task force out of a pool of about 600 candidates.

The council will meet for the first time from 5:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. on April 20 at the Windsor Community Center. Other work sessions have been set May 18 and once each in September, October and November.

The task force will explore northern Colorado's values, treasures, challenges and opportunities. The leadership group will be asked to guide the development of a process to move the region forward in four phases: values, scenario development, visioning and implementation.

Embrace Northern Colorado, which got its start through a federal grant as well as cash and in-kind donations from the private and public sector, plans an 18- to 24-month process of gathering public input and formulating strategies for growth.
