What's a Leadership Task Force?

How were candidates selected?

Candidates were selected from a pool of 800+ leaders who were identified by their peers through a social network study conducted by Colorado State University and the University of Northern Colorado. Additional candidates have since been invited to participate by the initial members of the Task Force seated on April 20, 2011, to fill gaps in representation the Task Force identified.

What is the role of the Leadership Task Force?

The role of the Leadership Task Force is to provide guidance in engaging the broader community in the development of creating a vision for Northern Colorado's future. Members will explore Northern Colorado values, key issues that define the quality of life in the region, growth trends affecting the future, how other regions have addressed challenges and what options might be available here. Drawing upon this discussion, the Leadership Task Force will develop an action plan that focuses on working together to preserve and enhance what is best about Northern Colorado.
